## DERIVATIVES

The Derivatives Market had two KCB contracts expiring in September 19, 2019 valued at Kes.79,000 transacted at a price of Kes.39.50. This is against a closing price of Kes.39.00 posted in the spot market.

## EQUITIES

Market turnover rose to Kes.779M from the previous session's Kes.266M, the number of shares traded stood at 24M against 9.8M posted yesterday.

## INDICES

All NSE Indices registered positive gains as follows;  
The NSE 20 share Index was up 8.60 points to stand at 2678.73.  
All Share Index NASI picked up 0.66 points to stand at 149.80.  
The NSE 25 Share index added 8.96 points to settle at 3608.14.

## Banking

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.506M transacted which accounted for 64.99% of the day's traded value. KCB Group was the day's main feature with 8M shares valued at Kes.313M changing hands at between Kes.38.80 and Kes.39.50. Equity Group Holdings down five cents to Kes.39.95 moved 3.7M shares valued at Kes.148M. Co-operative Bank moved 1.7M shares worth Kes.21M and closed at Kes.12.00.

## Energy & Petroleum

The Energy & Petroleum sector had shares worth 1.9M traded & accounted for 0.25% of the day's traded value. KenGen edged up 1.33% to Kes.6.08 with shares worth Kes.1.3M transacted.

## Manufacturing & Allied

The manufacturing and Allied sector had shares worth 17M traded & accounted for 2.23% of the day's traded value. E.A Breweries closed the day 1.01% higher to Kes.199.75 moving 86,000 shares valued at Kes.17M.

## Telecommunication


