The Derivatives market had 21 contracts worth Kes.973,000 transacted in today's trading session. 19 KCB contracts worth Kes.931,000 expiring in 19th March 2020 were concluded at a price of Kes.49.04. This is against an end of day price of Kes.46.65 posted in the spot market.

### EQUITIES

Market turnover surged to Kes.893M from the previous session's Kes.268M, the number of shares traded stood at 28M against 9.1M posted yesterday.

### Banking

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.280M transacted which accounted for 31.34% of the day's traded value. KCB Group actively moved 3.1M shares valued at Kes.144.9M at between Kes.46.00 and Kes.48.50. Equity Group Holdings down fifteen cents to Kes.48.00 moved 1.89M shares valued at Kes.91M. NCBA moved 642,000 shares worth Kes.22.4M and closed at Kes.35.00.

### Investment

The Investment sector had shares worth 13.8M traded & accounted for 1.55% of the day's traded value. Centum Investment moved 543,000 shares worth Kes.13.8M and closed at Kes.25.50.

### Manufacturing & Allied

The Manufacturing & Allied sector had shares worth 51M traded & accounted for 5.72% of the day's traded value. E.A Breweries moved 254,000 shares worth Kes.50.8M at between Kes.198.00 and Kes.201.00.

### Telecommunication

Safaricom was the day's main feature with 19M shares valued at Kes.544M changing hands at between Kes.28.05 and Kes.29.00; this represented 60.91% of the day's traded value.
