Market turnover retreated to Kes.630M from the previous session's Kes.1.6Bn and the number of shares traded stood at 24M against 44M posted yesterday.

Banking

The Banking Sector had shares worth Kes.233M transacted which accounted for 36.94% of the day's traded value. Equity Group Holdings actively moved 4.0M shares valued at Kes.144M at between Kes.34.50 and Kes.37.70. KCB Group had 1.3M shares traded valued at Kes. 50M and closed the day at Kes.38.00. Co-op Bank registered 1.2M shares valued at Kes.16M.

Energy & Petroleum

The Energy & Petroleum sector had shares worth 9.8M traded & accounted for 1.56% of the day's traded value. Kenya Power & Lighting moved 3.2M shares valued at Kes.6.2M at between Kes.1.90 and Kes.2.10. KenGen had shares worth Kes.1.9M traded and closed at Kes.4.93.

Manufacturing & Allied

The Manufacturing & Allied sector had shares worth 83M traded & accounted for 13.22% of the day's traded value. EA. Breweries moved 371,400 shares at between Kes.165.00 and Kes.175.00. Flame Tree Group Holdings traded 135,100 shares worth Kes. 110,000 and closed the session at Kes.0.81. B.A.T registered 68,900 shares worth Kes. 21M at a fairly stable price of Kes.315.00

Telecommunication

Safaricom was the day's main feature with 10.5M shares valued at Kes.291M changing hands at between Kes.27.50 and Kes.28.50; this represented 46.24% of the day's traded value.
